Simone Biles is one of the most decorated athletes of all time with a combined total of 30 Olympic and World Championship medals. Simone Biles was adopted at a young age by her grandparents who discovered that Simone also had ADHD (Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder). In school Simone struggled to pay attention and focus while doing school work. Gymnastics provided her with a way to be physically active and build her ability to focus. Simone Biles' story teaches us that even though we may have trouble paying attention in school, it does not mean we have to be ashamed or embarrassed of it, we just need to embrace this part of ourselves and find something that helps us focus. This may be sports, reading, music, or anything else we enjoy.</li></ul>

He is an inventor, scientist, and engineer who is credited with inventing and patenting the first practical telephone! He also had Autism and because of his Autism, he was able to create many inventions that helped people hear better, talk to one another, and communicate better. Stuttering is a speech disorder that causes the flow of your words to be disrupted. President Biden has stuttered his whole life. President Biden was born in Pennsylvania and when he learned to talk his mother noticed his stuttering. His mother told him, "Joey, do not let this define you. Remember who you are and you can do it." President Biden is quoted as saying, "So, every time I walk on stage, I hear my mother telling me to slow down and know who I am. It really does help me when I speak in front of people." President Biden's story is powerful because he is able to work through his stuttering to deliver messages to the</li></ul>
